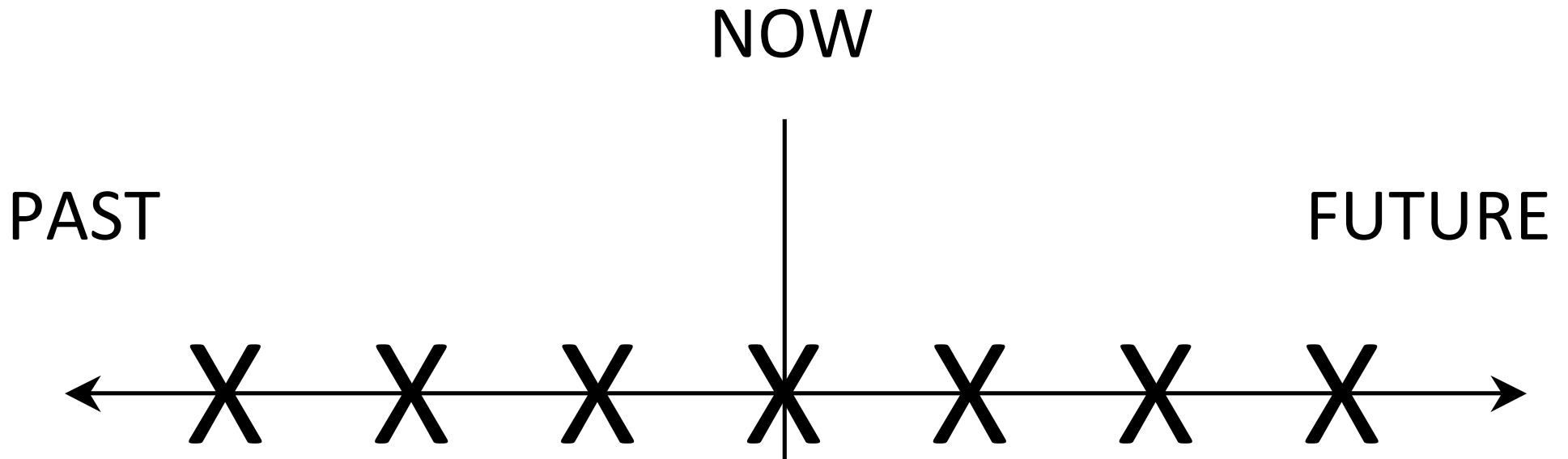
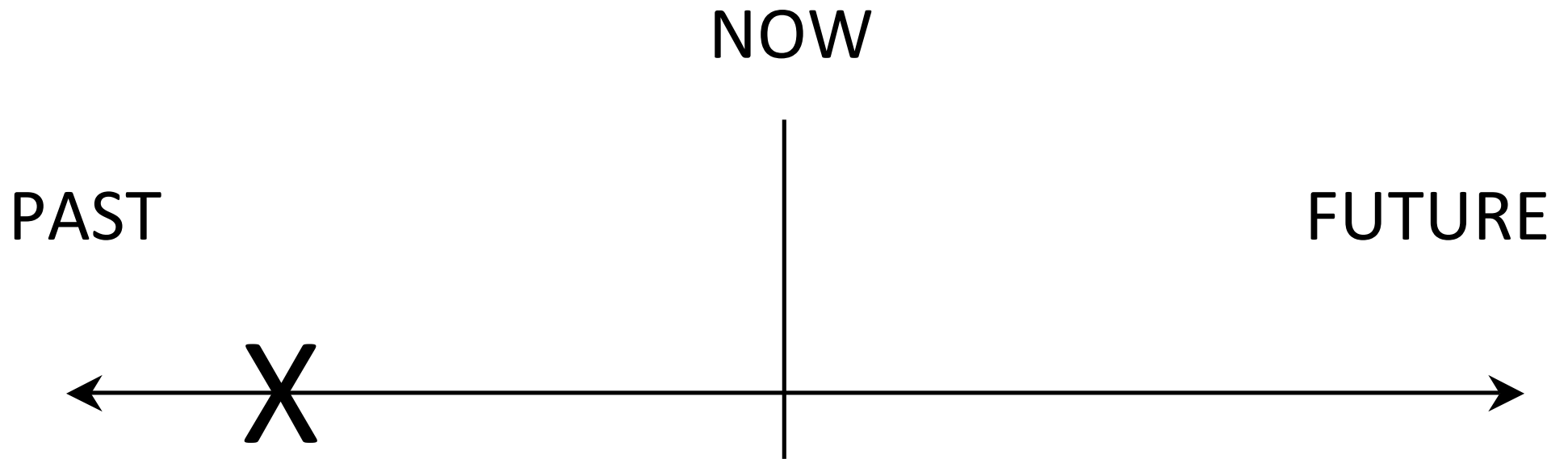


Simple Present Tense



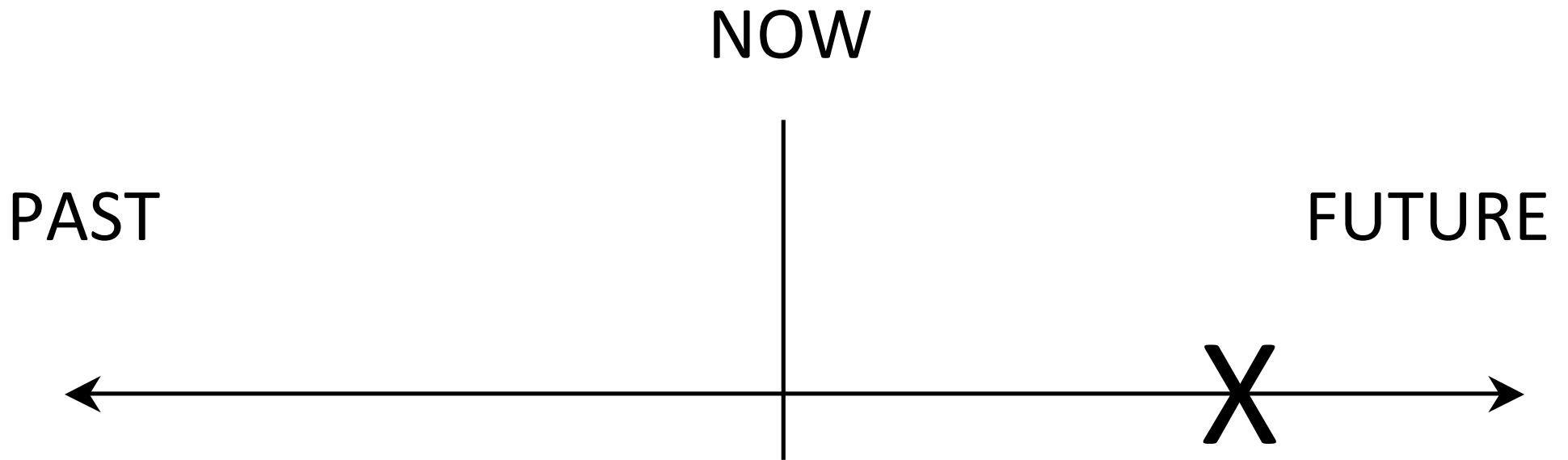
is an action that is repeated.

Simple Past Tense



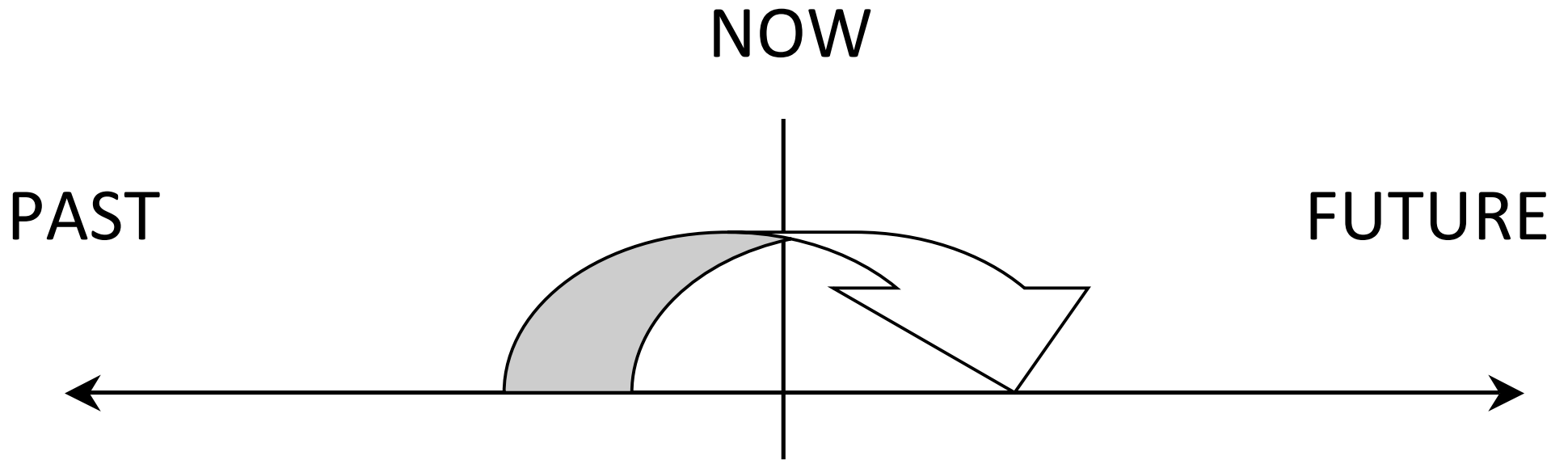
**is an action that started
and finished in the past.**

Simple Future Tense



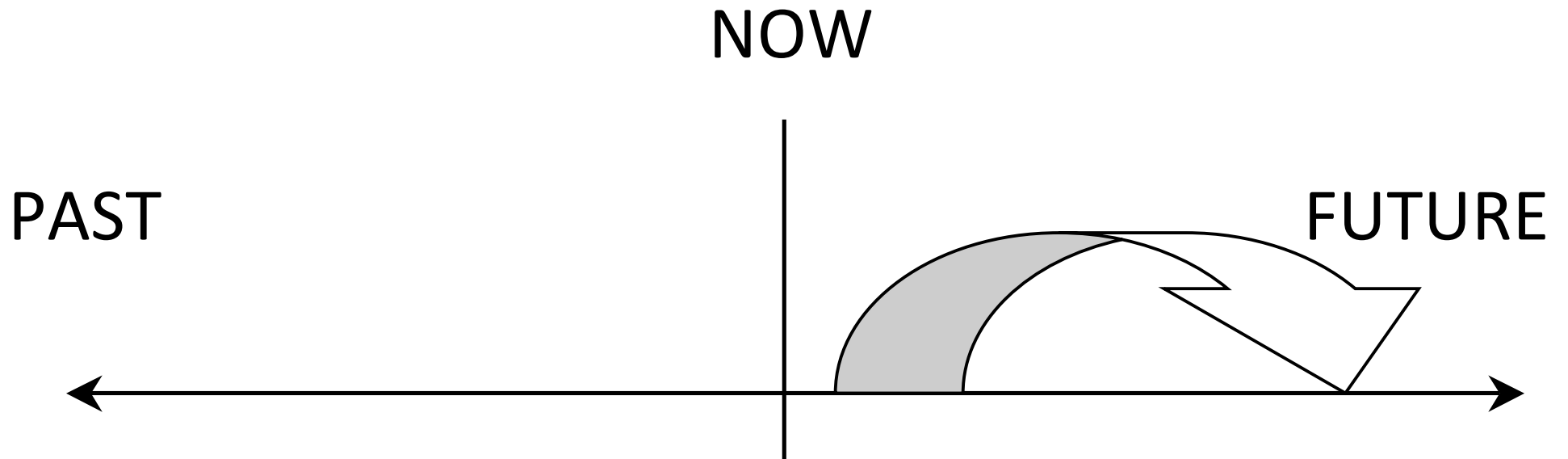
**is an action that is planned
to happen in the future.**

Present Continuous Tense



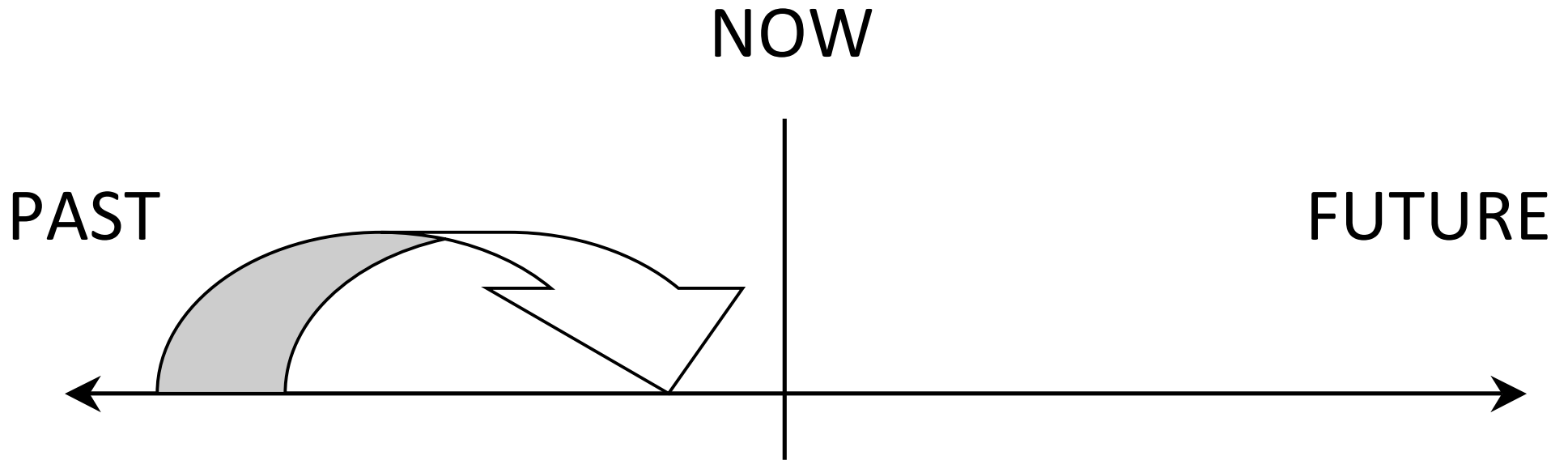
**is an action that is
happening now.**

Future Continuous Tense



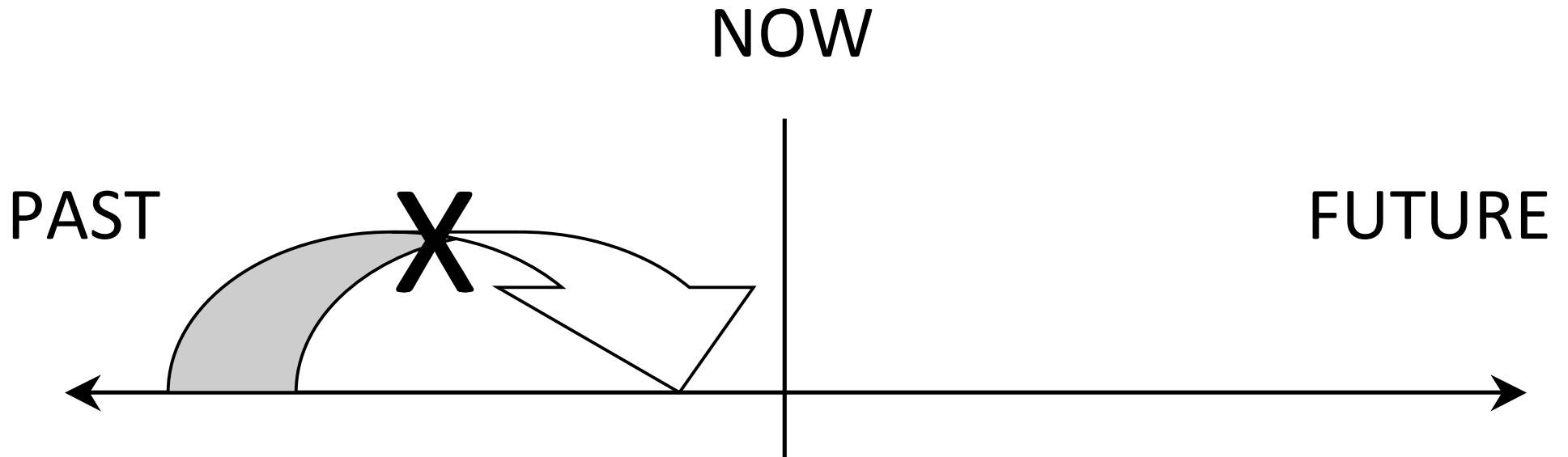
is a planned (long) action in the future that will be stopped.

Past Continuous Tense



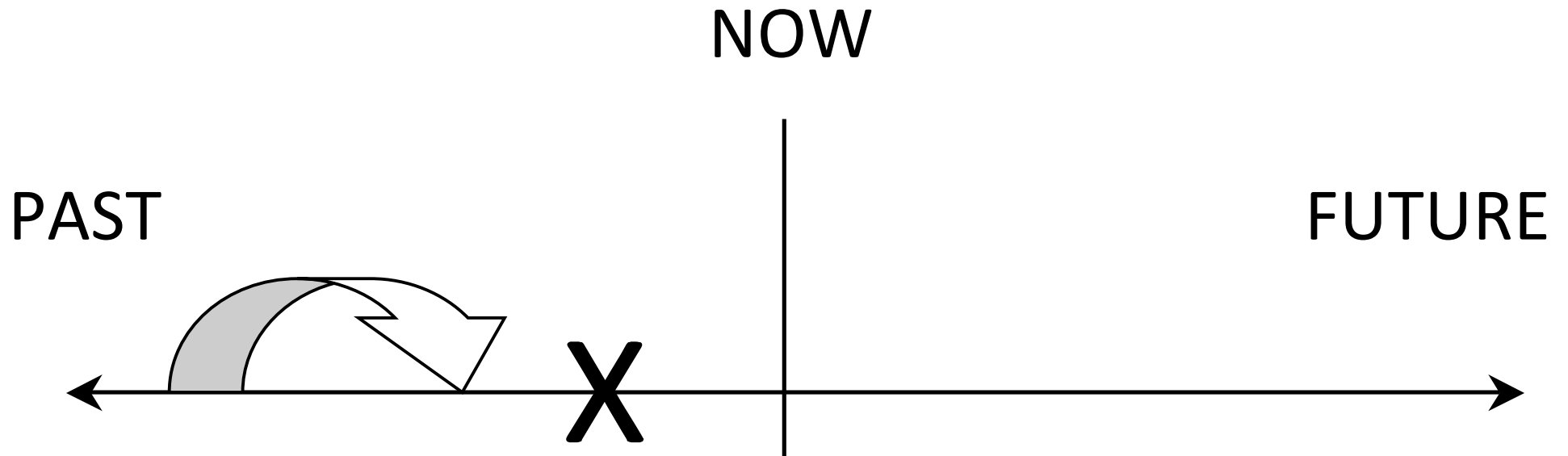
**is a long action in the past
that stopped.**

Present Perfect Tense



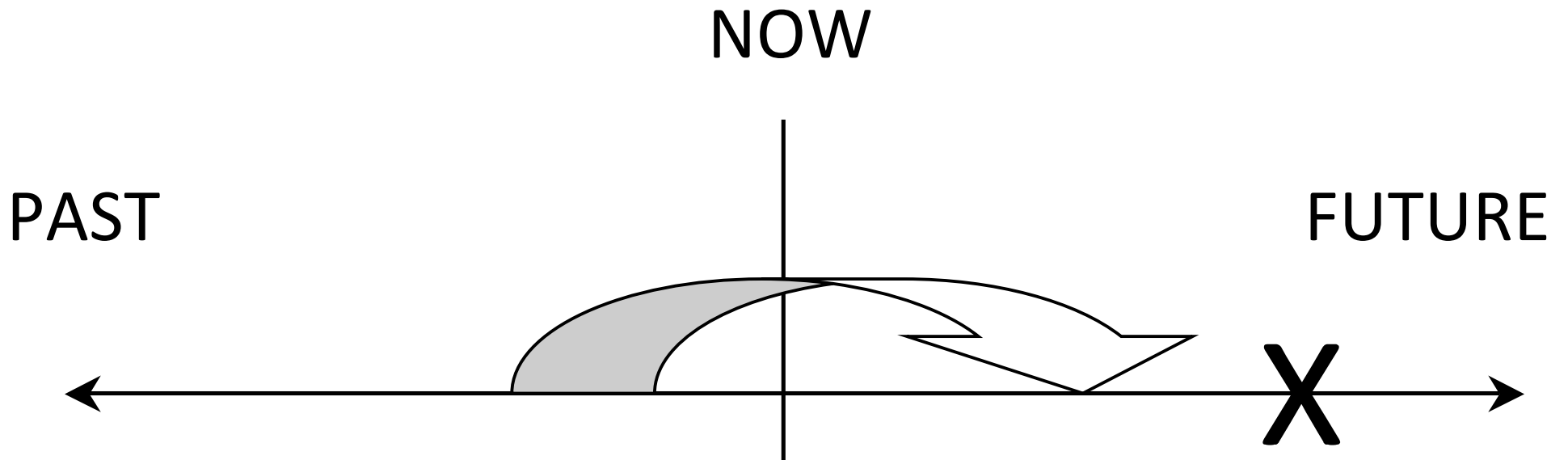
is an action that happened at some point in the past and was interrupted by another action.

Past Perfect Tense



is an action that happened before another action in the past.

Future Perfect Tense



is the idea that something will happen before another action in the future.
